


CHRISTIAN FAITH FORMATION


- Session Meeting Moderator is Kyle Anderson while Rev. Dr. Seth Thomas is on Sabbatical through September 30, 2024.
- Session Members in 2024 as of are: Andrew McLaurin, Teresa Bowers, Aaron Caruso, Sarah Condreay, Jimmy Parks, Nebiyu Tesfa, Ralph Buchan, and Maureen Kosa, Clerk of Session Carla Shafer, elected by Session until the 2025 Annual meeting when new and vacant leadership positions will be proposed by the Nomination Committee. Casey Morriss, 2024 Clerk of Session has been transferred by his work to Houston, Texas.
- Janice Smith who fills in as Head of Staff through 9/30/2024 presented her schedule and readiness to come with a prepared sermon on short notice. She is available by phone, email, and to come and assist as needed. Her email is janice@saintjamespres.org or smith.janice077@gmail.com
- Merrie Thomas of the Deacons announced this summer's Church picnic will be held on August 18, 2024 on the church front lawn after worship. Everyone is encouraged to bring their own lunches or alternatively organize meal sharing with a small circle of friends. Deacons will provide frozen desserts

- Nebiyu Tesfa, chair of the Nominating Committee reminded that we are searching for members to serve in available positions with the Nominating Committee, Deacons and Ruling Elders positions that are vacant. Church members are encouraged to volunteer.
- Ralph Buchan, Chair of the Personnel Committee, reported that the committee met well qualified candidates for the Music Director position, and Leah Bruno from Vancouver, BC will be hired to begin in September.

GUEST SPEAKING EVENT




WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

Let Justice Roll Down

You are invited to the 2024/25 Women's Bible Study beginning on September 24th. The theme for the year is "Let Justice Roll Down" with a focus on God's call to care for the earth, neighbors and all creation.

Author Patricia K. Tull describes her call for creation justice in this way:

"When I first learned of the climate crisis, I wondered how a biblical scholar with few practical skills could help. I found my purpose in learning about ecology and teaching people of faith what I could. Such is not everyone's skillset or desire, but each of us has something to do with our hearts."



You are invited to join with other St. James women as we explore, with our hearts, God's call to care for our neighbors and for creation. We will learn about the challenges we face in this time of accelerated climate change, and the possibilities available to address or counter the impact of human-made stress on our environment. We will hear God's words to us through the scripture and will have a chance to explore and discuss the theological questions that arise from our study.

We will meet at 10:30 on the last Tuesdays of each month, except for the final lesson which will be on the third Tuesday, June 17th at 10:30. We will not have a class in December.
