SESSION HIGHLIGHTS - SEPTEMBER 15, 2024



- Jimmy Parks reported for the Christian Faith Formation that the fall education program has been initiated as planned and the Church Retreat was successfully carried out. Tracy is filling 2 teacher vacancies which occurred due to schedule changes.
- Ralph Buchan reported for the Personnel Committee that an Ad for a new Treasurer has been posted, review will begin this week and finalists will meet with the Finance and Personnel Committee soon.
- Tess Bowers reported there will be a meeting 9/23/34. Its primary focus is the Advent Celebration.
- Maureen Kosa reported that the Mission Committee met and decided to develop a survey for congregation members about SJPC giving querying who we give to, what concerns they have about unmet needs, and where their interests lie in community mission/social action volunteering. She reminded about how many non-profit fund-raising events are being held this fall and winter.
- The Nominating Committee has 3 members and needs 4 more. One one-year term and three 3-year terms. A congregational meeting will be held on October 13, 2024 to fill vacant positions on the Nominating Committee.
- Ralph Buchan reported that the Personnel committee is reviewing and updating job descriptions, and Personnel Review conversations will begin in November.
- Sarah Condreay reminded that the October 6th luncheon to Welcome Seth will be catered by Fred Hartsook. It will be in the Fellowship Hall and everyone is welcome.
- Our church's Safety process is under development. Currently, we have people in the Narthex during worship who do a walk through at least once during worship. The back doors are locked from the outside and the upstairs doors provide Sunday morning access. If members have questions or concerns, please let the church office know.
- Session members were reminded to prepare budget information for the pledge drive for Church operations in 2025. As of 8/30/24, income and operating expenses are on track. 94% giving has been received and 25% of the year is left. Significant capital expenses for repairs to the Horizon Room will come out of investment earnings which have not yet been transferred.
- Aaron Caruso reported for Building and Grounds that Chris, an outdoor unhoused visitor to our building for many years, has left Bellingham and the raccoons have left. The issue appears resolved. The session expressed their appreciation to the staff and volunteers for how well and persistently they have taken care of the situation. The Horizon Room repairs have been completed. There are a few finishing touches.
- Aaron reminded that some church jobs need new volunteers (like parking sign placements and more). A list will be compiled so members will be able to volunteer to take on the tasks.

WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY


Let Justice Roll Down

You are invited to the 2024/25 Women's Bible Study beginning on September 24th. The theme for the year is "Let Justice Roll Down" with a focus on God's call to care for the earth, neighbors and all creation.

Author Patricia K. Tull describes her call for creation justice in this way:

"When I first learned of the climate crisis, I wondered how a biblical scholar with few practical skills could help. I found my purpose in learning about ecology and teaching people of faith what I could. Such is not everyone's skillset or desire, but each of us has something to do with our hearts."

You are invited to join with other St. James women as we explore, with our hearts, God's call to care for our neighbors and for creation. We will learn about the challenges we face in this time of accelerated



climate change, and the possibilities available to address or counter the impact of human-made stress on our environment. We will hear God's words to us through the scripture and will have a chance to explore and discuss the theological questions that arise from our study.

We will meet at 10:30 on the last Tuesdays of each month, except for the final lesson which will be on the third Tuesday, June 17th at 10:30. We will not have a class in December.
