FINANCE UPDATE

April finances were similar to what was reported for March. We continue to see a lag in the receipts of pledged support. Our expenses were higher than budget by about \$3,500. We did have an uptick in general offerings, boosted by the offering received on Easter. From an annual perspective we are on budget; however, this is probably the last month where that will be true.

As I previously reported, we are concerned that delayed receipt of pledged support coupled with unexpected increases in expenses will begin to negatively impact our finances in May or June. The treasurer is reviewing our expenses to see if there are bills that should be paid out of our endowment funds. The endowment accounts have some restrictions on use and the committee and Session are reviewing guidelines for use before expending any funds. There will be more to report on this next month.
